



Employed in the Golf Industry LPGA definition:

- owns, operated, manages, or works as an assistant in the operation or management of a recognized golf course, shop, club, or practice facility;
- engages in or supervises the teaching of golf at a recognized golf club, course, practice facility or at a recognized golf school;
- is self-employed as a teacher, consultant, coach or other position within the golf industry
- is employed as a full-time golf coach at an accredited high school or two (2) year or four (4) year university or college;
- is employed, other than primarily clerical, in administration, management, marketing, public relations, broadcasting, journalism, or sales by an approved golf association, old management company, or golf publisher, other than in a primarily clerical position
- is employed in retail management or sales of golf products or services, and has primarily managerial responsibilities; or
- is employed in management of a golf tournament of an approved golf association.

Employed in the golf profession is NOT:

- Past Employment that has ended
- Non-paid volunteer work
- Unpaid internship
