You do not have to take the PAT or submit a PAT equivalency before starting the Teacher Education Program (TEP) online courses. Anyone may take the online courses as an Associate or Non-Member. An equivalency is required for the Applicant program.

**The LPGA scoring equivalencies are as follows:**

Age 49 and under      First round score of 13 over the course rating or better, 5,100 yard minimum

Age 50+                First round score of 15 over the course rating or better, 5,100 yard minimum
